However, if any cognizable offence is made out, this order would not be a shield against the arrest of the accused.

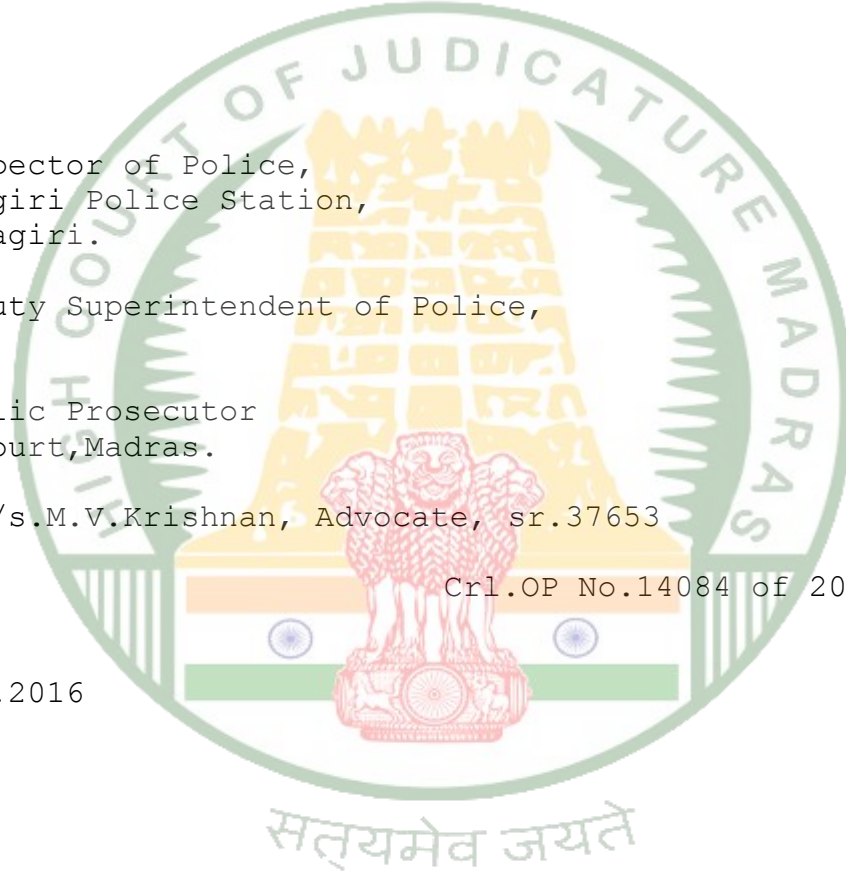
