2.When the matter was taken up for hearing, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that community

certificate was already issued to the petitioner's son on 06 February 2016 and the writ petition has become infructuous. He has also made an endorsement to the following effect:

"Community certificate already issued on 06.02.2016. Hence writ petition prayer become infructuous. May be permit the petitioner to withdraw this writ petition."

3.In view of the above, this writ petition shall stand dismissed as having become infructuous. No costs.
