It is seen that on the complaint dated 08.01.2015, given by the petitioner, the Inspector of Police, Central Crime Branch, Team-II and Anti Land Grabbing Cell, Chennai, have conducted thorough enquiry and closed the same on 11.07.2015. A copy of the closure report is furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Since the dispute is entirely civil in nature, no

positive direction can be given to the respondent-Police to register an FIR.

5. In view of the above, this Criminal Original Petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.
