4 In such circumstances, the first respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 05.06.2015, and pass appropriate orders thereon, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the authorized representative of the petitioner Association and to the other persons concerned, if any.

5 The writ petition stands disposed of with the above directions. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
