ORDER

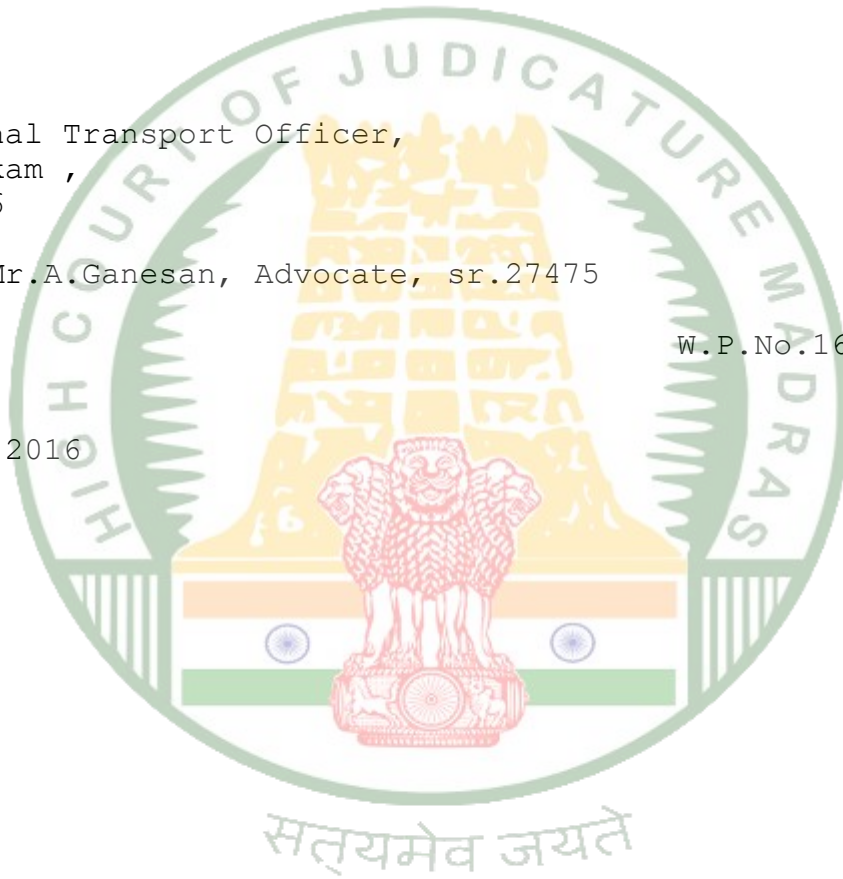
