3. It is seen that, on a complaint lodged by the petitioner's wife Gayathri against this petitioner, petition enquiry is pending before the 2nd respondent.

4. In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to co-operate with the police for enquiry and at the time of conducting enquiry, the petitioner shall not be harassed. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the 2nd respondent police is free to register an FIR

and this order shall not be a shield for the petitioner against arrest.
