4.Considering the rival submissions made on both sides, on the basis of the petitioner's complaint dated 17.12.2015, as enquiry is going on, the respondent police is directed to expedite the same and follow the dictum laid down in Lalitha

Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC) and register a case, if any cognizable offence is made out. The petitioner is directed to co-operate for enquiry.

5.The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.
