Since no order has been passed, the petitioner has come forward to file this writ petition.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to submit a fresh representation to the respondent, well in advance for conducting the cultural program in connection with the Temple festival and on receipt of the same, the respondent is directed to consider and pass orders as expeditiously as possible, within a period of one week thereafter, in accordance with law and inform the decision taken, to the petitioner.

5. The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
