Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a writ of mandamus, to direct the 2nd respondent to give permission with protection to conduct the Aadal, Padal cultural function at Sempakurichi Colony Public Stage, in connection with Muthumariamman Thiru Ther Vizha of Arulmigu Sree Muthumariamman Temple, Sempakurichi Colony, Chinna Salem Taluk, Villupuram District scheduled on 05.06.2016 based on the petitioner representation dated 31.05.2016.

O R D E R

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2 The petitioner claims to be a resident of Sempakurichi village, Chinna Salem Taluk, Villupuram District. He submitted a representation/application dated 31.05.2016 to the respondent, seeking permission to conduct a cultural program on 05.06.2016, which includes song and dance programme, in connection with the temple festival of Arulmighu Sree Muthumariamman Temple, situate at Sempakurichi Colony, Chinna Salem Taluk, Villupuram District, and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, would submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there will not be any law, order or communal problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4 This Court heard the submissions of Mr.K.Thangapandian, learned Government Advocate, who accepts notice for the respondent.

5 This Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the 2nd respondent to consider the application/representation dated 31.05.2016, in accordance with law and pass orders on or before 03.06.2016 and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner forthwith.

6 The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
