Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a writ of mandamus, to direct the respondents to give permission to conduct a festival program of Arulmighu Aadhiparasakthi Kaaliamman Thiru Kalyana Urchava Thiruvizha at 15th Ward, Viruthambut, Vellore-6 schedule to be held on 08.06.2016 in Yearly festival in the village by considering the petitioner's representation dated 26.05.2016.

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2 The petitioner claims to be the Headman [Naatanmai] of Viruthambut Village, Katpadi Taluk, Vellore District. He submitted a representation/application dated 26.05.2016 to the 2nd respondent, seeking permission to conduct a cultural program on 09.06.2016, in connection with the Yearly festival of Arulmighu Aadhiparasakthi Kaaliamman Thiru Kalyana Urchava Thiruvizha which includes song and dance programme and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, would submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there will not be any law, order or communal problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4 This Court heard the submissions of Mr.R.Govindasamy, learned Special Government Pleader, who accepts notice for the respondents.

5 This Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the 2nd respondent to consider the application/representation dated 26.05.2016, in accordance with law and pass orders on or before 06.06.2016 and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner forthwith.

6 The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
