Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a writ of mandamus, to direct the 2nd respondent to give permission to conduct the dance programme in the event of Sri Seliamman Kovil festival on 08.06.2016 at Kallwayhaill [vill] & [P.O.], KRP Dam [Vali], Krishnagiri District.

O R D E R

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2 The petitioner claims to be the Oor Goundar of Kallwayhalli village. He submitted a representation/application dated 27.05.2016 to the 2nd respondent, seeking permission to conduct a cultural program on 08.06.2016, in connection with the temple festival of Sri Seliamman Kovil situate at Kallwayhaill [vill] & [P.O.], KRP Dam [Vali], Krishnagiri District, which includes song and dance programme and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, would submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there will not be any law, order or communal problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4 This Court heard the submissions of Mr.P.Sanjay Gandhi, learned Additional Government Pleader, who accepts notice for the respondents.

5 This Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the 2nd respondent to consider the application/representation dated 27.05.2016, in accordance with law and pass orders on or before 06.06.2016 and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner forthwith.

6 The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
