Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a writ of mandamus, to direct the respondent authority to give permission to conduct the dance program at Pulamedu Sri Koothandavar Thirukovil Thiruvizha on 12.06.2016 and the petitioner representation dated 26.05.2016 at D.No.63/3/, Pulamedu, Kollaimesu Post, Anaikadu Taluk, Vellore District.

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2 The petitioner claims to be Head of the Organizing Committee of the Temple Festival of Sri Koothandavar Thirukovil, situate at Pulamedu, Kollaimesu Post, Anaikadu Taluk, Vellore District. He submitted a representation/application dated 26.05.2016 to the respondent, seeking permission to conduct a cultural program on 12.06.2016, in connection with the temple festival, which includes song and dance programme and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, would submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there will not be any law, order or communal problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4 This Court heard the submissions of Mr.K.Thangapandi, learned Government Advocate, who accepts the submission of the respondent.

5 This Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the respondent to consider the application/representation dated 26.05.2016, in accordance with law and pass orders on or before 10.06.2016 and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner forthwith.

6 The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
