Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a writ of mandamus, to direct the respondents to give permission to conduct the dance programme on 09.06.2016 in the event of Sri Mariamman Thirukoil of Uttamalai Village, Hoganakkal Post, Pennagaram Taluk, Dharmapuri District 636801.

O R D E R

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2 The petitioner claims to be the Dharmakarthha of Sri Mariamman Temple situate at Uttamalai village, Hoganakkal Post, Pennagaram Taluk, Dharmapuri District. He submitted a representation/application dated 01.06.2016 to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent, seeking permission to conduct a cultural program on 09.06.2016, in connection with the temple festival which includes song and dance programme and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, would submit that the function which is to be held on 09.06.2016, has been postponed to 10.06.2016 and would further submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there will not be any

law, order or communal problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4 This Court heard the submissions of Mr.R.Vijayakumar, learned Additional Government Pleader, who accepts notice for the respondents.

5 This Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to consider the application/representation dated 01.06.2016, in accordance with law and pass orders by 09.06.2016 and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner forthwith.

6 The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly.
