Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a writ of mandamus, to direct the respondent to grant permission to conduct cultural program in Sri Ponniyamman Temple, scheduled to be held on 16.06.2016 at about evening hours at Sri Ponniyamman Temple, Anpoondi Village, Vellore Taluk, Vellore District, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 05.06.2016.

O R D E R

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2. The petitioner claims to be the Member of the Festival Committee of Sri Ponniyamman Temple, situate at Anpoondi Village, Vellore Taluk, Vellore District. He submitted a representation/application dated 05.06.2016 to the respondent, seeking permission to conduct a cultural program on 16.06.2016, in connection with the temple festival, which includes song and dance programme and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, would submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there will not be any law, order or communal problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4. This Court heard the submissions of Mr.S.Pattabiraman, learned Government Advocate, who accepts notice for the respondent.

5. This Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the respondent to consider the application/representation dated 05.06.2016, in accordance with law and pass orders by 14.06.2016 and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner forthwith.

6. The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
