This Miscellaneous Petition has been filed, seeking to condone the delay of 443 days in preferring the Criminal Appeal, against the judgment made, in S.C.No.66 of 2011 dated 11.12.2014 on the file of the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Coimbatore.

2. Various reasons have been stated by the petitioner for the delay in the filing of the Criminal Appeal.
