Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for a writ of mandamus, to direct the respondent to give permission to the petitioner to conduct a cultural program schedule to be held on 24.06.2016 Shri Mariamman, Shri Kaliamman, Shri Kadappanasiamman temple, at No.4/44, Ganthi Nagar, Jollarpettai, Thirupattur, Vellore District by considering the petitioner representation dated 31.05.2016.

ORDER

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2 The petitioner claims to be one of the Organizers of the Festival Organizing Committee of the Temple, viz., Shri Mariamman, Shri Kaliamman, Shri Kadappanasiamman Temple, situate at Gandhi Nagar, Jollarpettai, Thirupathur, Vellore District. He submitted a representation/application dated 31.05.2016 to the respondent, seeking permission to conduct a cultural program on 24.06.2016, in connection with the temple festival, which includes song and dance programme and since, he has not been favoured with any kind of response, came forward to file this writ petition.

3 Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, would submit that in the event of permission being granted to conduct the song and dance programme, there

will not be any law, order or communal problem and no vulgarity or obscenity will be there and hence, prays for appropriate orders.

4 This Court heard the submissions of Mr.R.Govindasamy, learned Special Government Pleader, who accepts notice for the respondent.

5 Though the petitioner has prayed for a larger relief, this Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the application/representation, directs the respondent to consider the application/representation dated 31.05.2016, in accordance with law and pass orders on or before 21.06.2016 and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner forthwith.

6 The writ petition is disposed of, accordingly. No costs.
