ORDER

This Civil Revision Petition is filed against the order and decree passed by the learned Additional Sub Judge, Virudhachalam, in I.A.No.366 of 2009 in O.S.No.66 of 2005, dated 16.07.2009, to set aside the ex parte decree.

Mr.G.Parthasarathy, the learned counsel, representing Mr.S.Sathish Rajan, the learned counsel for the revision petitioner submitted that even before the filing of this Civil Revision Petition, the learned Additional Sub Judge, Viruduchalam, passed a final decree in the Suit itself, and has also made an endorsement to that effect on the reverse of the memorandum of grounds of this Revision Petition today.
