ORDER

The respondent initiated proceedings in H.M.O.P.No.2375 of 2011 before the Principal Family Court, Chennai, against the petitioner praying for a decree of divorce. The petitioner is therefore before this Court to fix outer time limit for disposal of the proceedings.
