In view of the said submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, there shall be a direction to the respondents to consider the representations of the petitioners dated 07.05.2010 and 30.4.2010 on merits and in accordance with law and pass suitable orders within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy

of this order.

5. Writ petitions are disposed of accordingly. No costs.
Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
