During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made

out, the respondent Police is free to register an FIR and this order shall not be a shield for the petitioner against arrest.

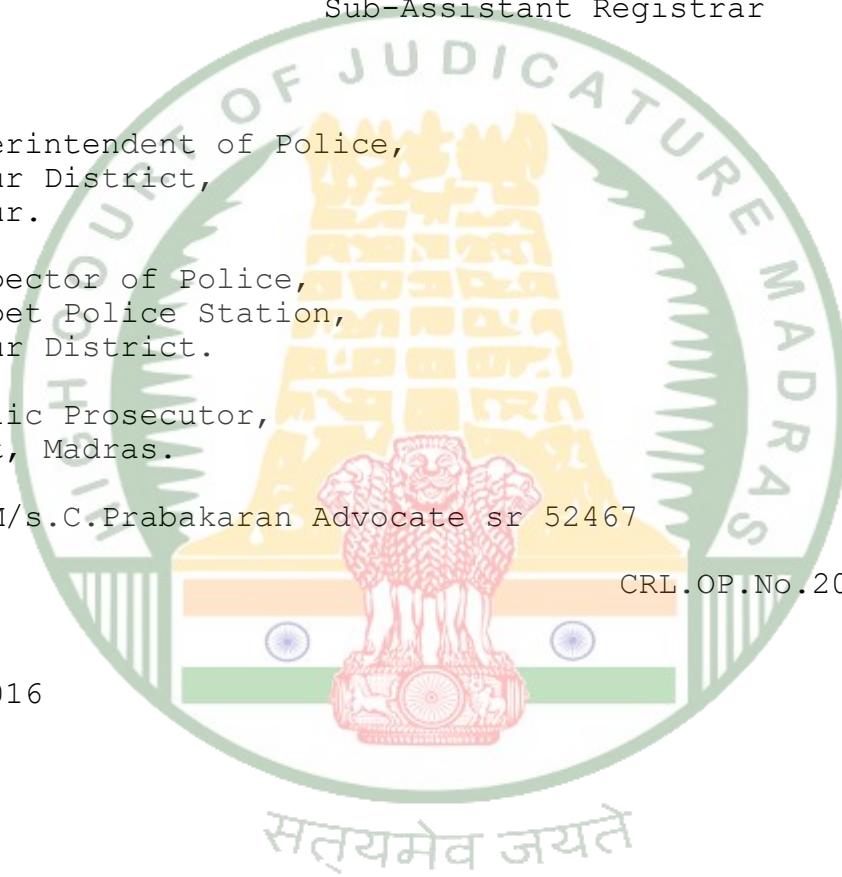
