For conducting the Teachers' Eligibility Test, guidelines have been laid down vide G.O.Ms.No.181 dated 15.11.2011, inter alia, keeping in mind the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP(Civil).Nos.18227 to 18228 of 2008 dated 20.08.2008.

2. The prayer made in the petition is that these guidelines should be followed while carrying out the Teachers' Eligibility Test.

3. Learned Government Pleader states that the guidelines will be adhered to.

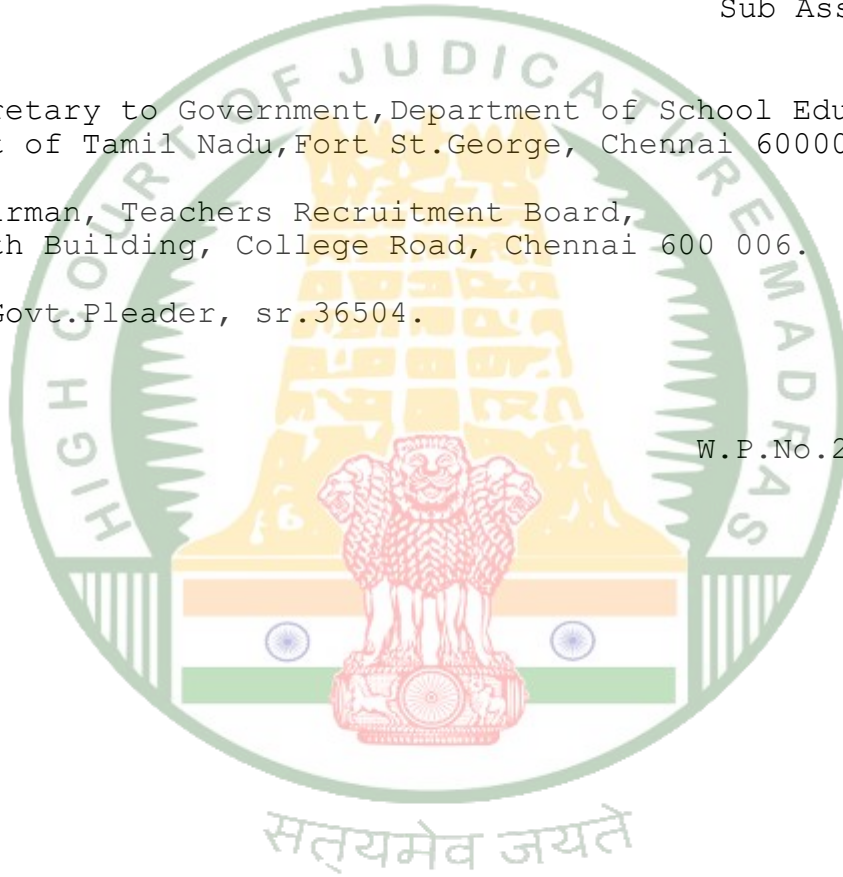
