ORDER

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2 The petitioner claims to be the co-owner of the land admeasuring to an extent of 3 acres and 56 cents of vacant plot in TS.No.131/1, 131/2, 131/3 situate at Kalki Krishnamurthy

Salai [Lattice Bridge Road], Tiruvanmiyur, by way of succession and when the petitioner along with the other co-owners wanted to dispose of the property, they were shocked to note that very many fraudulently fabricated documents came into existence and in this regard, a detailed representation dated 07.03.2016 was sent to the respondents 1 and 2 and though it was received and acknowledged, no response was forthcoming and hence, the petitioner had sent a reminder dated 05.06.2016 to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent and since it has also failed to invoke any response, the petitioner came forward to file this writ petition.

3 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.R.Govindasamy, learned Special Government Pleader who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents 1 and 2.

4 This Court, taking into consideration the limited scope of prayer sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the same, directs the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 07.03.2016 as well as the reminder dated 05.06.2016 in accordance with law, after putting on notice, the respondents 3 to 7 and pass orders within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner as well as to the respondents 3 to 7.

5 The writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.

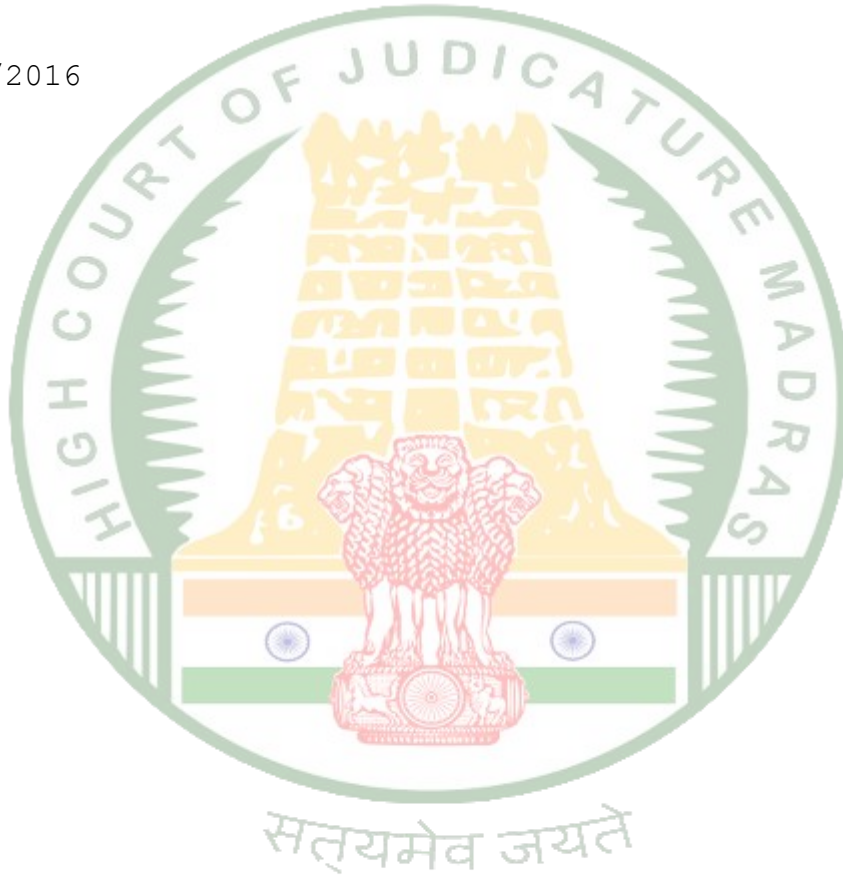
