We have perused the affidavit filed by the second respondent. We are satisfied that at last, action against encroachments has been taken. Some actions have been completed, while other actions are in progress.

2.We are thus of the view that the only direction that is to be made is for the respondent/authority to complete the action against encroachment, whether it be 6th respondent or other respondents, as is apparent from the affidavit filed by the second respondent.

3. The writ petition accordingly stands disposed of, leaving the parties to bear their own costs.

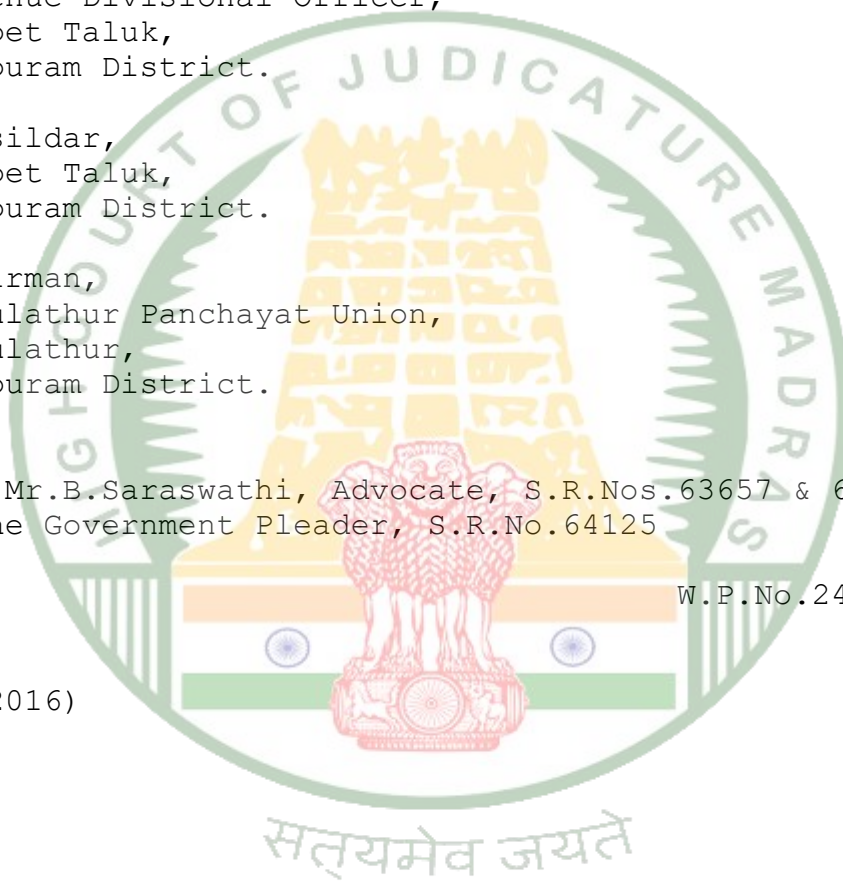
