2 The petitioner would state that he along with his family were staying in Door NO.11, S.M.Nagar Slum area, Nandanam, Chennai-600035. On 16.01.2004, a fire accident took place in which his hut and other huts were destroyed and in this regard, the petitioner has repeatedly submitting the representations for allotment of alternate house and since no response is forthcoming, the petitioner is constrained to approach this Court, by filing the present writ petition.

4 Though the petitioner has prayed for a larger relief, this Court, taking into consideration the above facts and circumstances and without going into the merits of the same, directs the 1st respondent to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representations dated 05.06.2015 and 06.06.2016 on merits and in accordance with law and pass orders within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner.

5 The writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
