The petitioner, who is the wife of the detenu Kani @ Velkani, son of Samudhiram, aged about 52 years, has come forward with this petition, challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent dated 30.12.2015 against her husband branding him as a "Black Marketer" under the Prevention of Black Marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act, 1980 (Central Act 7 of 1980).

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 would submit that the order of detention passed by the third respondent as against the husband of the petitioner dated 30.12.2015 has been revoked by the Government in G.O.[Rt]No.72, Food and Consumer Protection(EI) Department, dated 11.02.2016 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.
