Prayer: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS, to call for the records relating to the detention order passed by the third respondent in C.No.02/PBMMSEC Act/IS/2016, dated 21.6.2016 and quash the same as illegal and to direct the respondents to produce the body and person of the petitioner's husband, namely Senthil @ Senthilkumar, son of Natesan, aged about 42 years, detained in the Central Prison, Coimbatore, before the court and set him at liberty, forthwith.

ORDER

This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed by the wife of the detenu, namely, Senthil @ Senthilkumar, aged about 42 years, son of Natesan, to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus, to call for the records, in C.No.02/PBMMSEC Act/IS/2016, dated 21.06.2016, passed by the third respondent, detaining the detenu, under Section 3(1) read with Section 3(2)(b) of the Prevention of Black Marketing and Maintenance of Supplies of Essential Commodities Act, 1980 (Act 7 of 1980), in the Central Prison, Coimbatore, and to quash the same and to direct the Respondents to produce the body of the detenu and set him at liberty forthwith.

2. At this stage of the hearing of the Habeas Corpus Petition, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondents 2 and 3 would submit that the order of detention passed by the third respondent, against the detenu, dated 21.6.2016, has been revoked by the Government, in G.O. Rt. No.310, Cooperation, Food and Consumer Protection (E1) Department, dated 24.8.2016 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is dismissed, as infructuous.

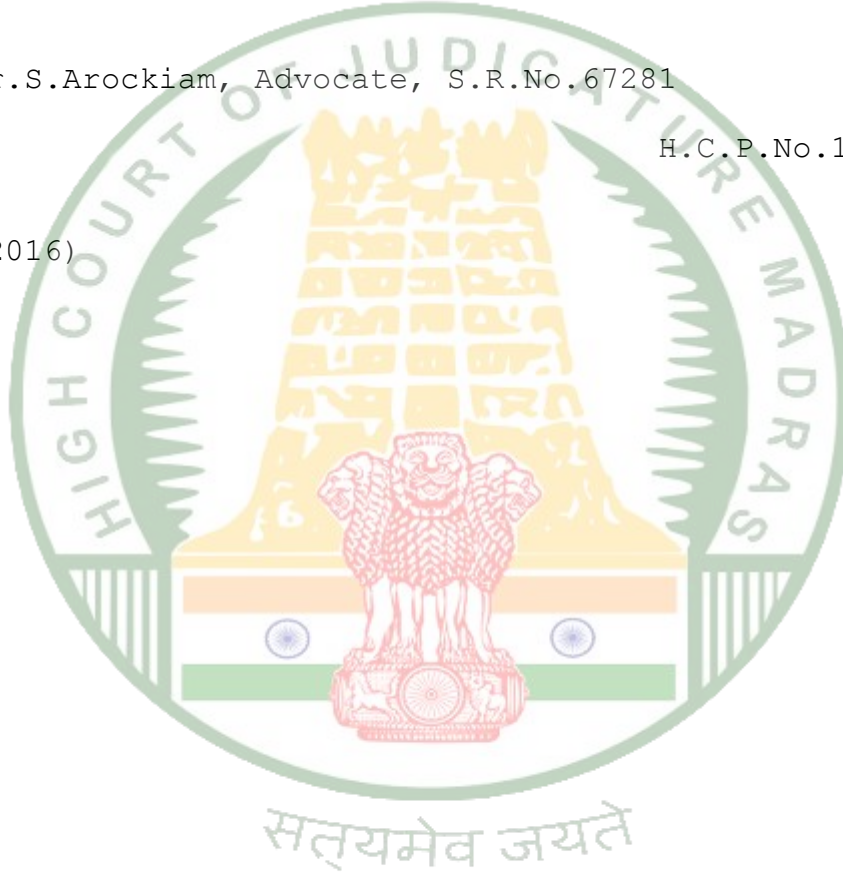
