2. The second respondent who is the Inspector of Police, Morappur Police Station has produced the detainee and the first detainee has been enquired about the relationship between her and the petitioner and she stated that the petitioner is her husband.

3. Considering the fact that the petitioner is not present and also considering that the detainee have been produced, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

4. In fine, the petition is dismissed.

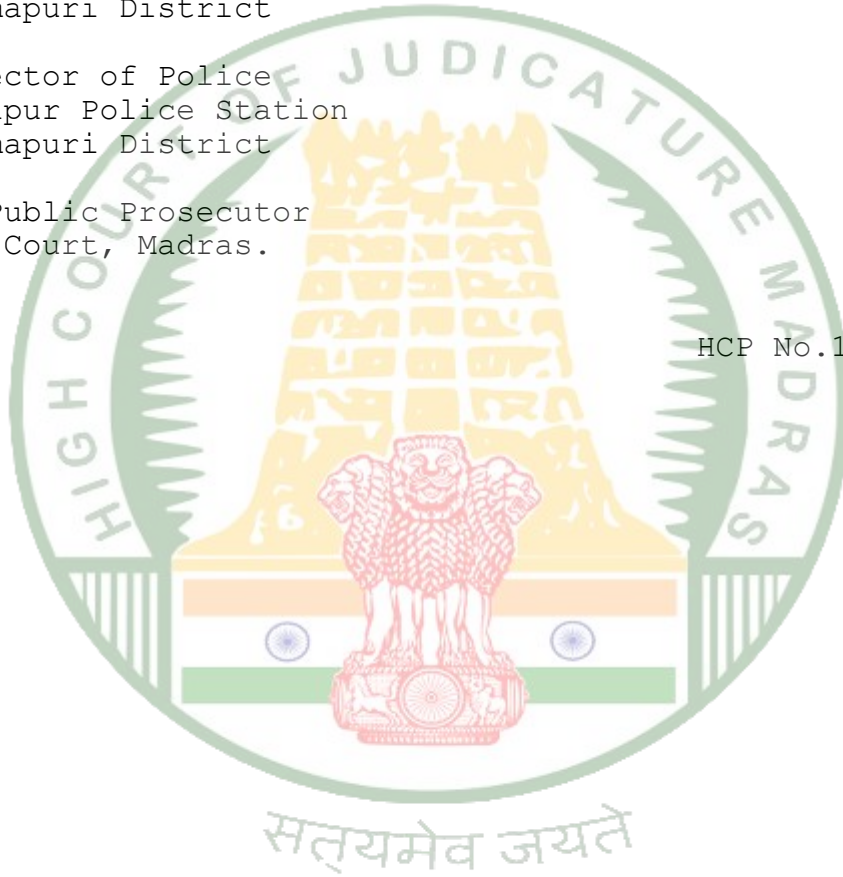
