Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of Mandamus directing the 1st respondent herein to consider the petitioner's representation dated 05.10.2015 and regularize the petitioner service as " Ticket Sales Man" in the 2nd respondent temple with all service and monetary benefits.

O R D E R

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2. The case of the petitioner is that he was employed by the second respondent as Ticket Sales Man on daily wage basis from June 2001 and from 01.06.2011. He was paid consolidated pay.

3. The petitioner would further state that the Government of Tamil Nadu had announced a scheme to regularize the temple workers and accordingly the first respondent issued a circular to identify the temple staffs employed on daily wage basis and consolidated pay for the purpose of regularization of service. Though the second respondent has recommended the name of the petitioner, he was not regularized as on date and therefore, he sent a representation dated 05.10.2015 to the first respondent for regularizing the service of " Ticket Sales Man" in the second respondent temple. Since no order has been passed, the present writ petition has been filed.

4. Heard the submissions of Mr.S.V.Karthikeyan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.K.V.Dhanapalan, learned Addl.Govt.Pleader, who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. This Court, considering the limited prayer sought for in the writ petition and without going into the merits of the case, directs the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 05.10.2015 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner.

6. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
