This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to direct the first respondent to trace out and produce the detenue by name Devi Durga alias Aarthi aged 22 years who is the wife of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner is present and he has been identified by his counsel.

3. The first respondent, who is the Inspector of Police, Guduvancherry Police Station has produced the detenue and she has been identified by the petitioner/ her husband.

4. Considering the above said circumstances, the relief sought in the petition has become infructuous.

5. In fine, the petition is dismissed. Consequently, connected Crl.M.P.Nos.9520 and 9715 of 2016 are also dismissed.

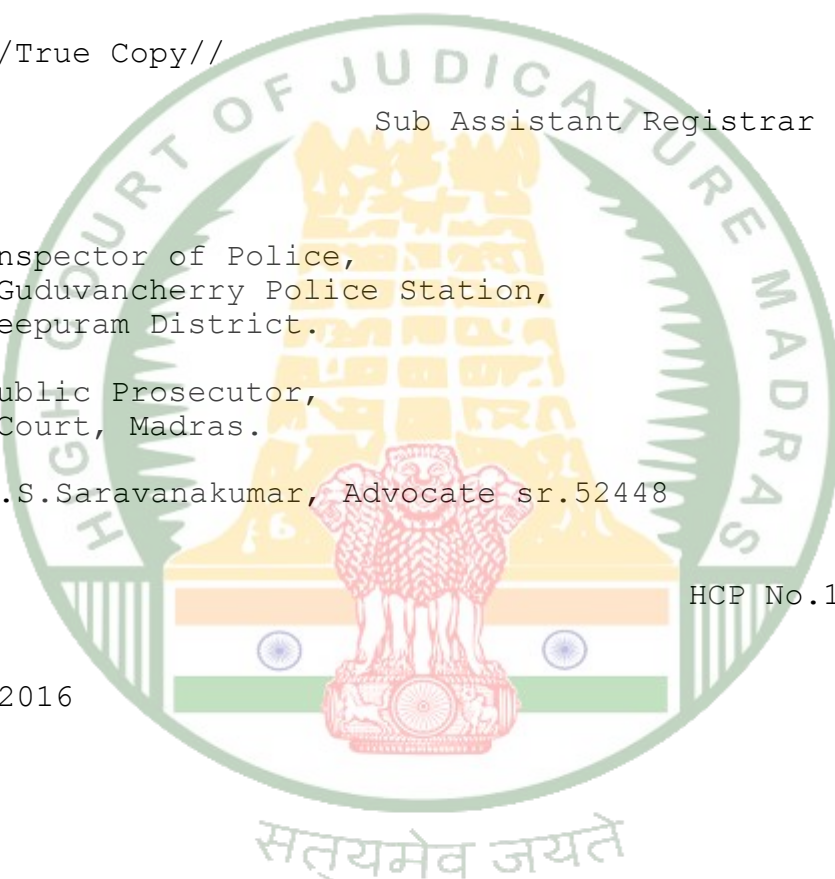
