4.Considering the rival submission made on both sides, the respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and follow the dictum laid down in ***Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)*** and register a case, if any cognizable offence is made out.

The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.
