ORDER

2.The learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the said representation made by the petitioner has been received by them.

3.Considering the submissions made and the facts and circumstances of the case, the writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 29.07.2016 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

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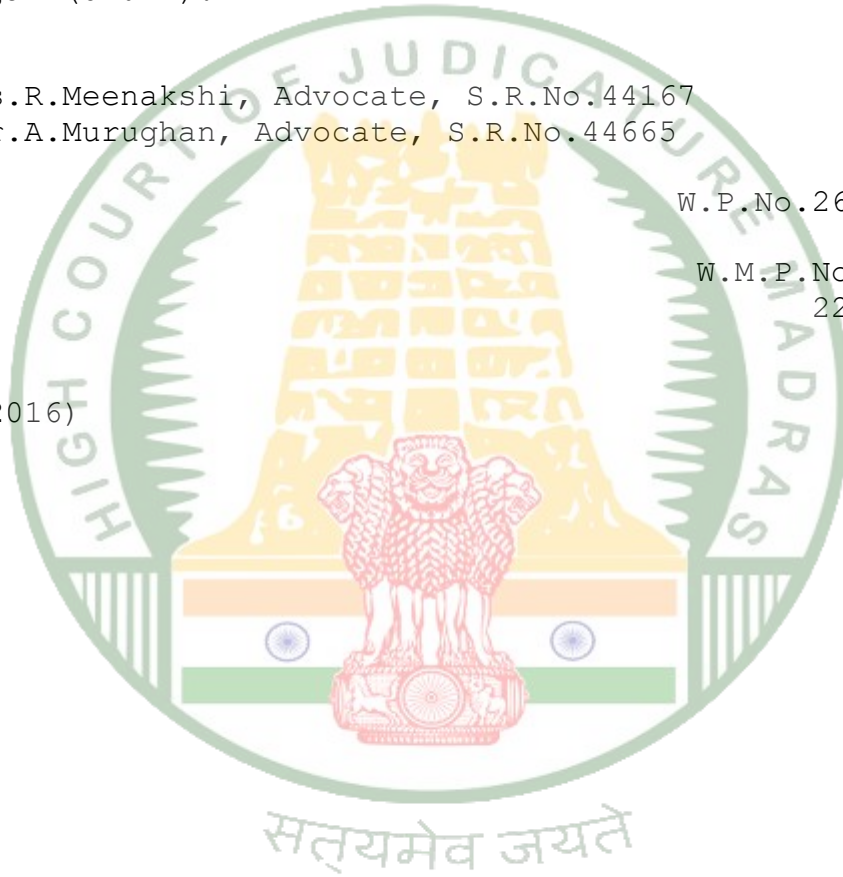
