Prayer in W.P.2510/12:Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus to direct the second respondent to increase the Pension Dearness Allowance like the Central Government to the petitioner and also to increase the medical allowance to the petitioner from a sum of Rs.15/- to Rs.500/- per month along with Freedom Fighters Pension.

Prayer in W.P.35860/2016:Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus

to direct the second respondent to increase the medical allowance of the petitioner from a sum of Rs.500/- to Rs.2000/- per month along with Freedom Fighter Pension by considering the petitioner representation dated 29.08.2016.

Prayer in W.P.36272/2016:Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus to direct the second respondent to process his application and forward the same to the first respondent to grant him Swantantrata Sainik Samman Pension under the Scheme.
