ORDER

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2 The petitioner claims to be the absolute owner of the property admeasuring to an extent of 0.21 cents out of 1.72 cents comprised in S.No.4/1 situate at Mummuni Village, Vandavasi Taluk, Tiruvannamalai District and she was issued with a joint patta No.710 in respect of the 0.850 Hectares of land. The petitioner had approached the respondents 1 and 2 in the form of representation / application dated 21.07.2016 for survey and measurement of the land and since no response is forthcoming, she came forward to file the present writ petition.

3 Heard the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.R.A.S.Senthilvel, learned Additional

Government Pleader, who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4 Though the petitioner has prayed for a larger relief, this Court, in the light of the above facts and circumstances and without going into the merits of the same, directs the 2nd respondent to entertain the representation / application of the petitioner dated 21.07.2016, if the papers are otherwise in order and after putting the concerned person/s on notice, shall pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, after putting on notice, the person/s concerned, if any and pass orders within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner as well as to the person/s concerned.

5 The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
