Prayer:- This Writ Petition is filed to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the 2nd Respondent to consider and pass orders on the representation of the Petitioner dated 1.8.2016 to disburse the retirement benefits with 18% interest on delayed payment to the Petitioner, who was allowed to retire from service on 31.1.2016.

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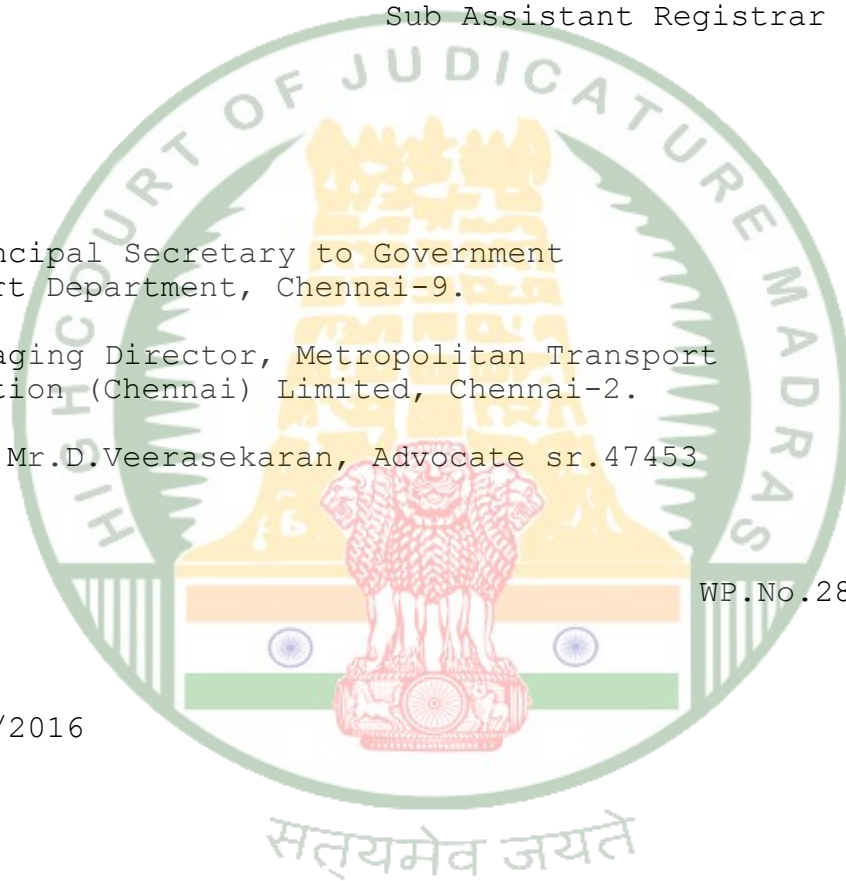
