O R D E R

Heard Mr.I.Abrar MD Abdullah, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, Mr.T.M.Pappiah, learned Special Government Pleader, takes notice for the first respondent and Mr.Bharadwaj, learned Standing Counsel, takes notice for the second respondent. With the consent of the learned counsel on either side, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal.

2. Learned counsel for the parties state that as recorded in the order dated 05.05.2005 reported in 2005(5) SCC 1 (State of U.P. Vs. Jai Bir Singh), the question of law has been referred to the Larger Bench of the Honourable Supreme Court, i.e., whether the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1949, would apply to educational institutions. Interim orders have been operating in the present matter.

3. In view of the aforesaid position, the Writ Petition is disposed of by agreement that the interim orders would continue till the disposal of the matter by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the parties would naturally remain bound by the legal position enunciated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on such decision being rendered. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
