4. In view of the above, blanket order of not to harass cannot be granted and the petitioner is directed to co-operate with the police for enquiry. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent police is free to register an FIR and this order shall not be

a shield for the petitioner against arrest.

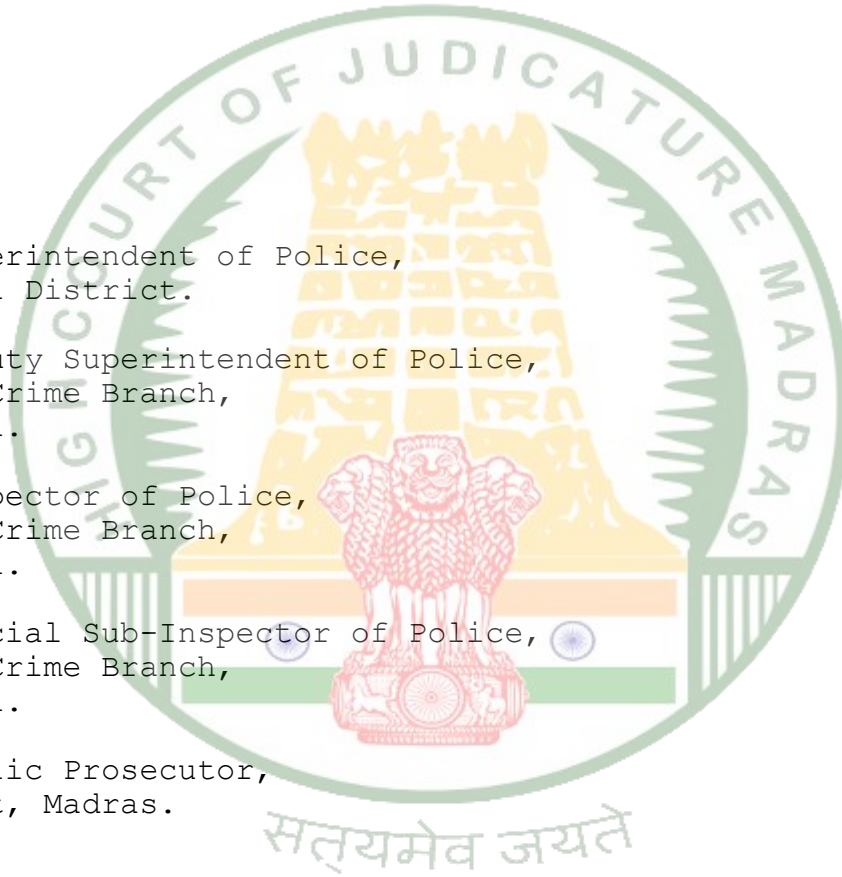
