W.P.No.2996 of 2016 is filed under Article 226 of The Constitution of India praying to issue a writ of certiorarified mandamus to call for the records relating to the order No.1060/DCE/T(P)/Kist/Vol-III/2015-16/407 dated 23.01.2016 passed by the 2nd respondent and quash the same and consequently direct the 2nd respondent to consider the petitioner representation dated 07.12.2015 for reduction of kist amount due to the heavy rain and flood in respect of Arrack Shop No.21 (M) Chettipet of Mannadipet Commune.

W.P.No.2731 of 2016 is filed under Article 226 of The Constitution of India praying to issue a writ of mandamus to direct the 2nd respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 07.12.2015 for reduction of kist amount due to the heavy rain and flood in respect of Arrack Shop No.21 (M) Chettipet of Mannadipet Commune.
