4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of by directing the petitioner to pay the one time tax as quantified by the respondent and on such payment, the goods in question shall forthwith be released.

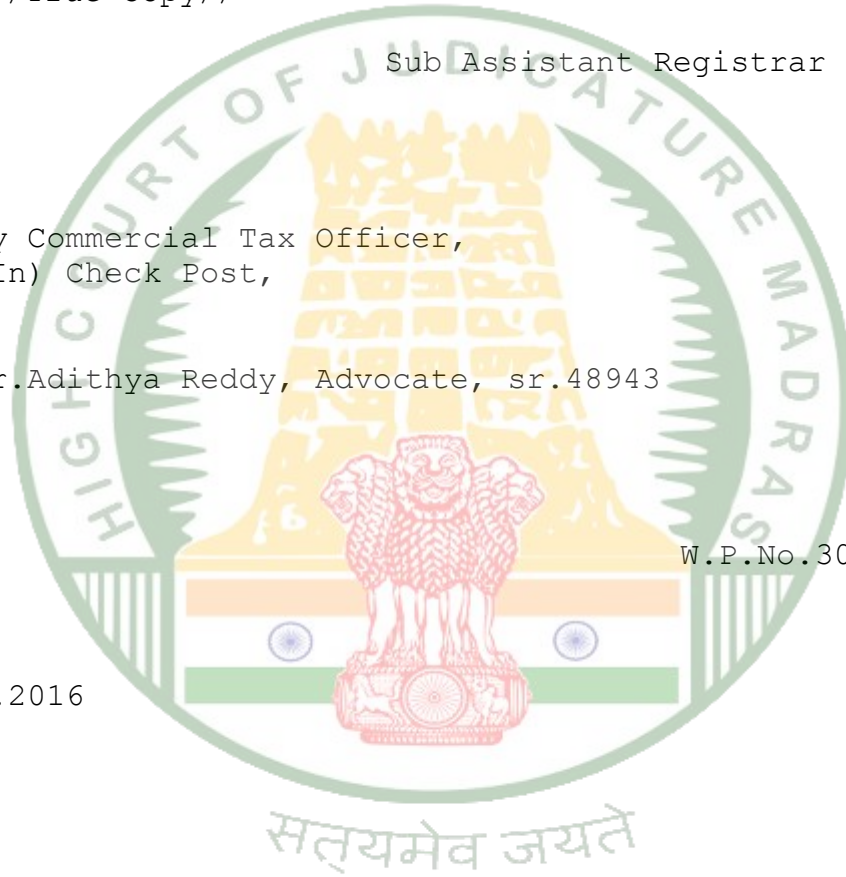
