Consequently, the learned counsel for the petitioner made an endorsement that he is withdrawing the writ petition in view of the settlement already arrived at in the above Civil Miscellaneous Appeal. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

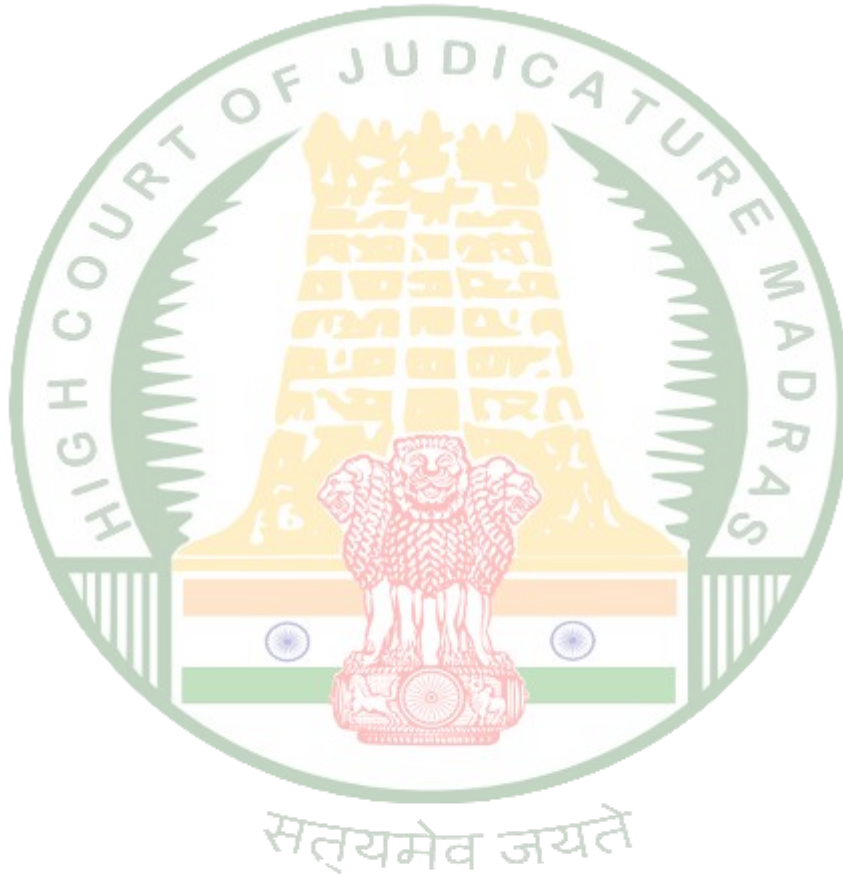
