ORDER

The petitioner has come forward with this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking a direction to the respondent to file a final report in Crime No.9 of 2014.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner, a case has been registered in Crime No.9 of 2014 for the offences punishable under Sections 465, 468, 471 and 506(i) of IPC. 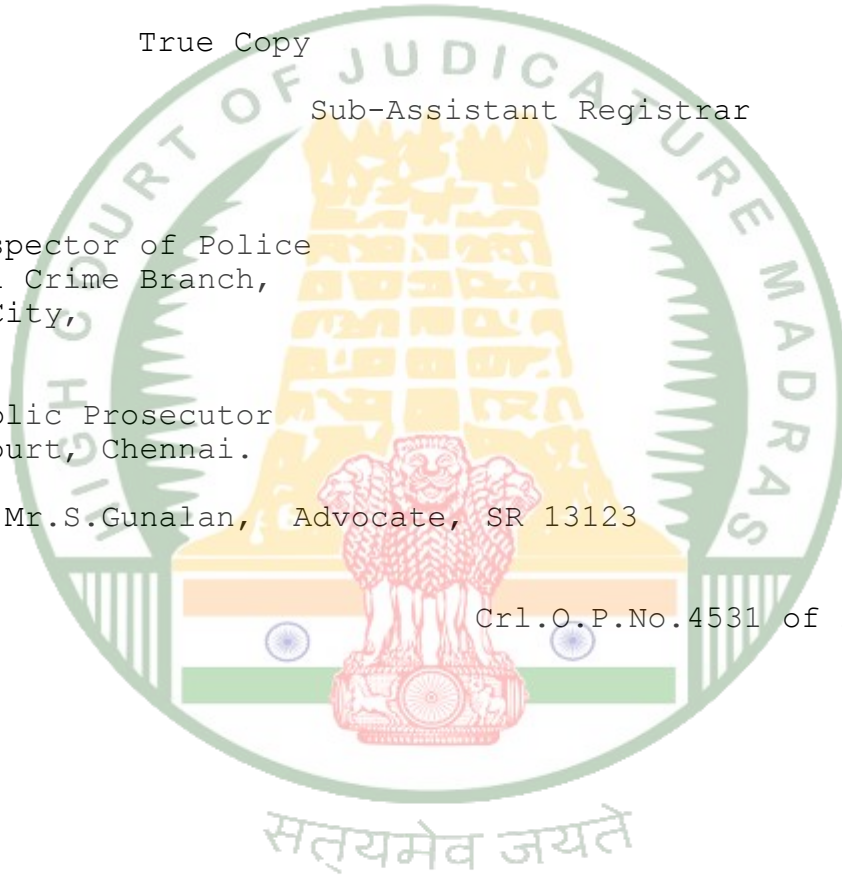
