2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has lodged a complaint before the respondent on 16.02.2016, for which, C.S.R.No.194 of 2016 has been assigned. But the respondent has not shown any interest to enquire the matter and register the case. Hence, the petitioner has come forward with this petition for the above stated relief.

3.At this juncture, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, would submit that on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner, petition enquiry in C.S.R.No.194 of 2016 is going on.

on the basis of the complaint made by the petitioner, as

enquiry is going on in C.S.R.No.194 of 2016, the respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and follow the dictum laid down in Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC) and register a case, if any cognizable offence is made out.

5. The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.

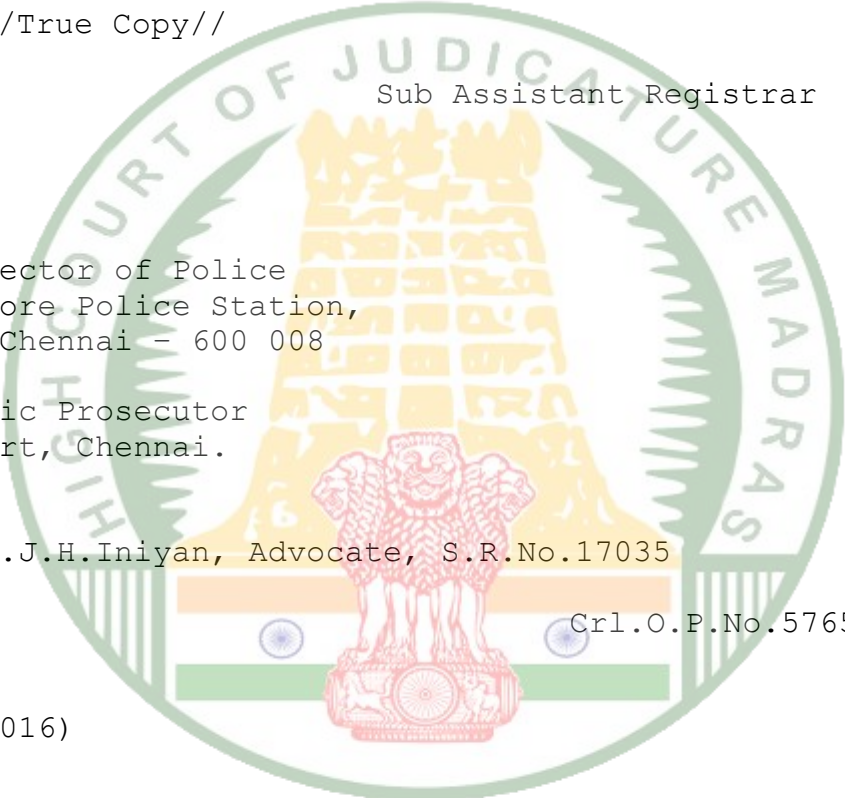
