The petitioner has come forward with this petition seeking for a direction to the respondents to register the case based on the petitioner's complaint dated 10.03.2016.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has lodged a complaint before the respondents on 10.03.2016. But the respondents have not shown any interest to enquire the matter and register the case. Hence, the petitioner has come forward with this petition for the above stated relief.

3.Learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, would submit that on the basis of the petitioner's complaint, enquiry is going on.

4.Considering the rival submissions made on both sides, on the basis of the petitioner's complaint dated 10.03.2016,

as enquiry is going on, the second respondent police is directed to expedite the same and follow the dictum laid down in Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC) and register a case, if any cognizable offence is made out. The petitioner is directed to appear before the second respondent for enquiry on 04.04.2016.

5.The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.
