The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that on the complaint dated 09.03.2016 given by the petitioner, a petition enquiry was conducted in CSR.No.72 of 2016 and after conducting enquiry, the respondent police has closed the same on 19.03.2010 on the ground that the incident alleged by the petitioner had taken place in Andhra Pradesh.
