ORDER

Mr.S.Diwakar, learned Sepcial Government Pleader accepts notice for the respondents. Heard both. By consent, the writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

2. Though the petitioner seeks a positive direction to release the lorry in question, which has been seized for alleged illicit transportation of sand, it is seen that there is a representation pending before the respondents.

3. In view of the same, without going into the merits of the contention raised by the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of directing the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 9.9.2016 on merits and pass appropriate orders thereon in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner

or her authorized representative, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.

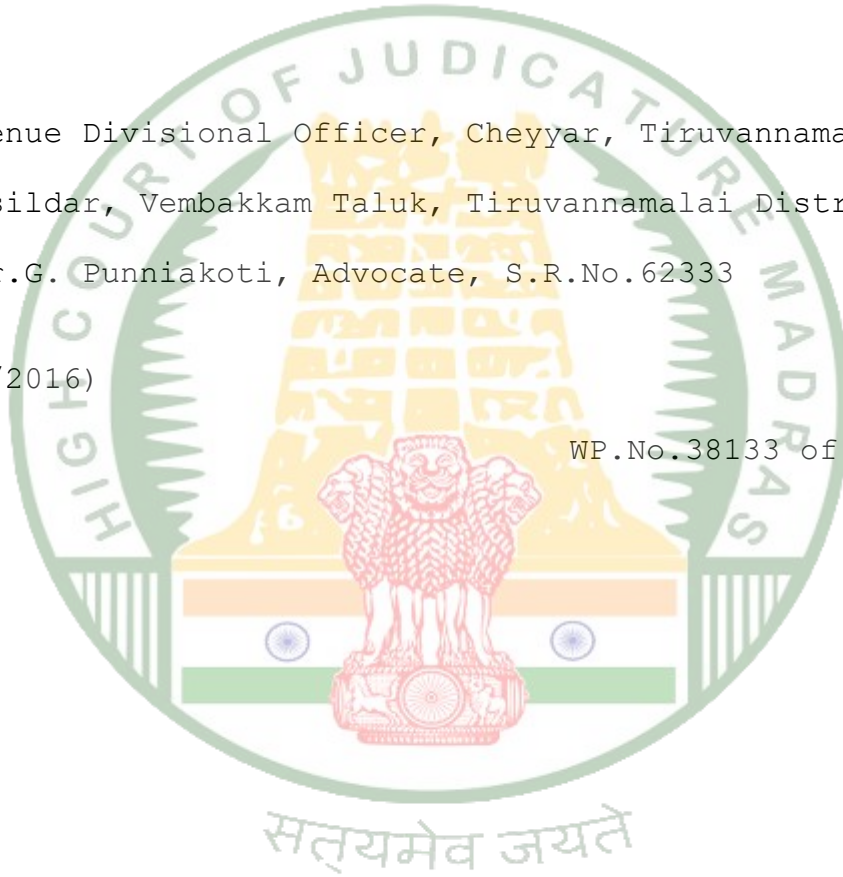
