ORDER

petitioner/accused is directed to appear before the Court when the learned Trial Judge directs.

4.In the result, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

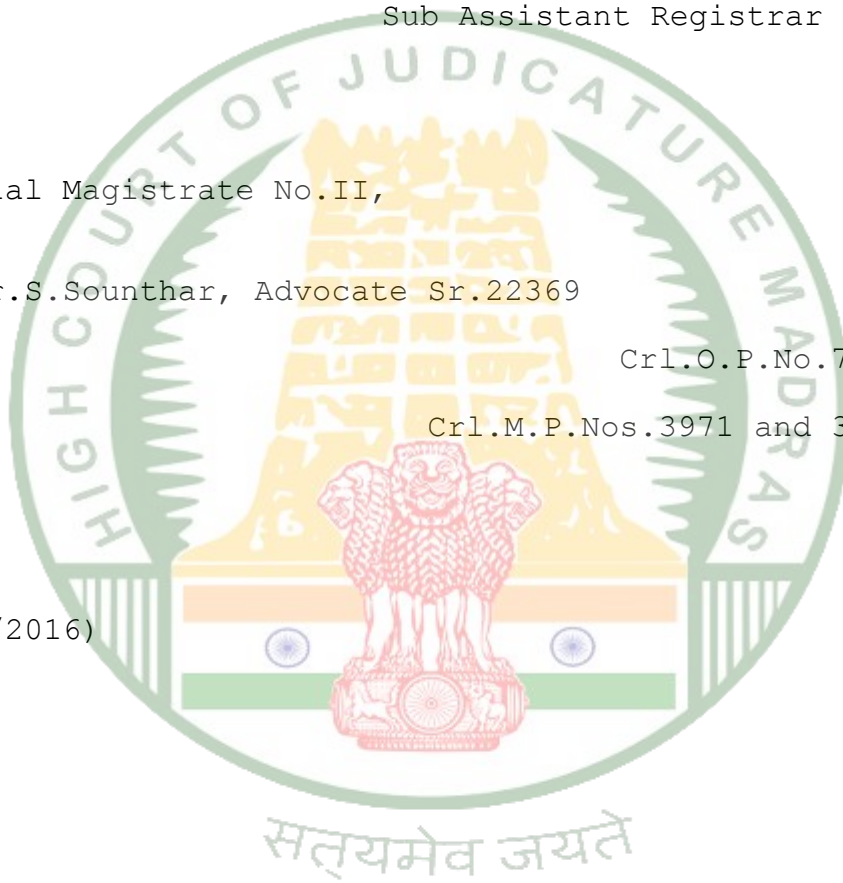
