Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, praying to direct the respondents particularly the second respondent to expedite the investigation in Crime No.2 of 2015, proceed against the accused persons in accordance with law, and punish them for the offences detailed in the petitioner's complaint dated 22.05.2014 and consequently, direct the 2nd respondent to file final report for the concerned court within a specified time.

ORDER

The petitioner has come forward with this petition seeking a direction to the second respondent police to file the final report in Crime No.2 of 2015.

2.Heard the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on either side.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner dated 22.05.2014, a case has been registered in Crime No.12 of 2014 for the offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 406, 506(ii) of IPC and under Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act r/w.

Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition Harassment of Women Act by the first respondent and the same was forwarded by the first respondent to the second respondent for want of jurisdiction and the same was registered in Crime No.2 of 2015 on 15.02.2015 by the second respondent. However, the second respondent has not shown any interest to investigate the matter and lay a final report. Hence, the petitioner has come up with the present petition for the relief as stated above.

4.Resisting the same, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that investigation is going on and hence, he prays for six months time to complete the investigation and file a final report.

5.Considering the submissions made on both sides, the second respondent is directed to complete the investigation in Crime No.2 of 2015 and file a final report, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.
