J U D G M E N T

(Judgment of the Court was delivered by The Hon'ble Chief Justice)

It appears that because of the lapse of time, the persons who are beneficiaries of the impugned order have lost their interest in the matter other than those who already stand permanently absorbed, being respondent Nos.4, 11, 13 and 14, qua whom the appeal has become infructuous. The learned counsel for the appellant states that despite their endeavour to locate the addresses from the Union and serve the remaining respondents at the given addresses, they appear to have shifted or are not available at the given addresses.

2. We feel keeping this appeal pending would be a futile exercise and thus dispose of the appeal with a direction that if any other respondents come forthwith to claim their rights, the matter can be revived. No costs.

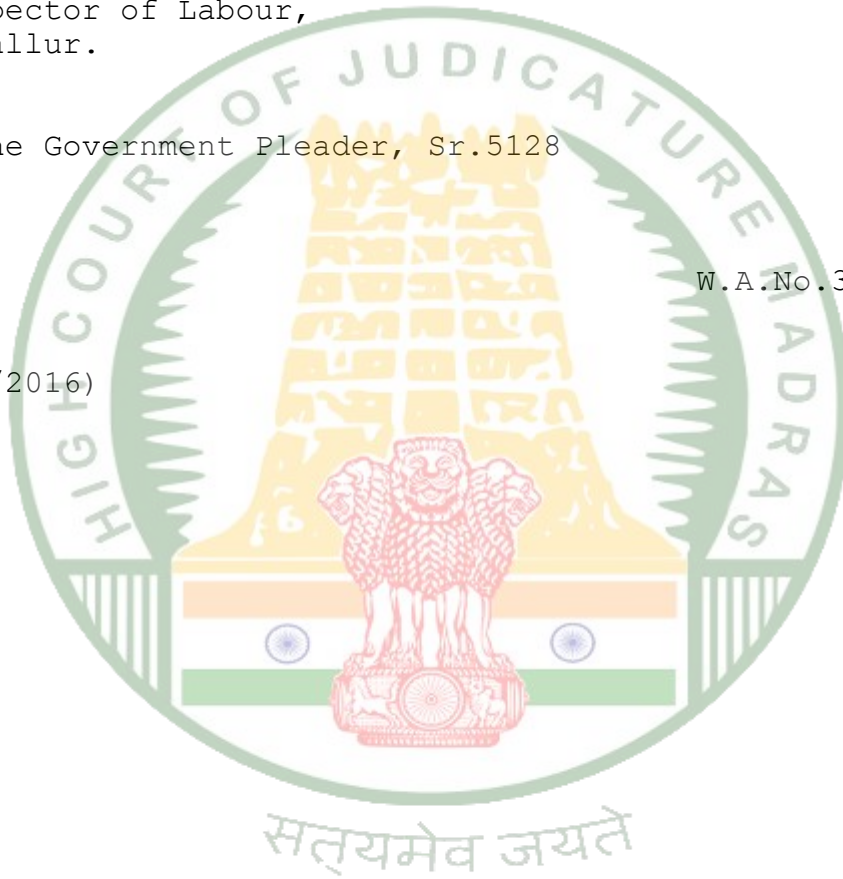
