2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

3. Considering the nature of the prayer sought for and taking note of the fact that the petitioner is prepared to surrender before the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Villupuram, (Special Judge for SC/ST Act Cases), there shall be a direction to the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Villupuram,

(Special Judge for SC/ST Act Cases), to consider the bail application to be submitted by the petitioner along with his surrender before him on the same day on merits and pass appropriate orders. The criminal original petition is ordered accordingly.

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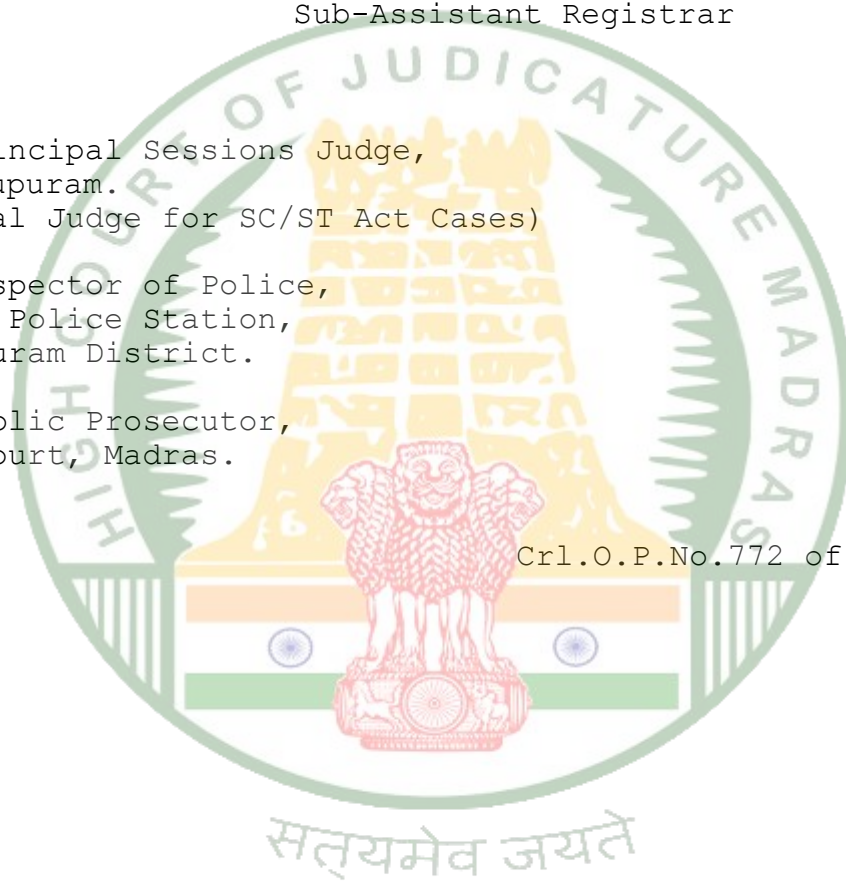
