Prayer in W.P.No.4400 of 2016: Writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus to direct the third respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 4/1/2016 for the grant of license/permission to run bunk shop and pass orders and till such time, forbear the third respondent, their officials, servants from in any manner interfering with the running of the petitioner's bunk shop at Whalen's Road, 2<sup>nd</sup> Gate, opposite to Corporation Office, Egmore, Chennai 600 008, wherein selling tea, coffee, food and other snacks is being undertaken.

Prayer in W.P.No.4401 of 2016: Writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus to direct the third respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 4/1/2016 for the grant of license/permission to run bunk shop and pass orders and forbear the third respondent, their officials, servants from in any manner interfering with the running of the petitioner's bunk shop at Ethiraj Salai, Wellington Estate, 1<sup>st</sup> Gate, Egmore, Chennai 600 008, wherein selling tea, coffee, food and other snacks is being undertaken.

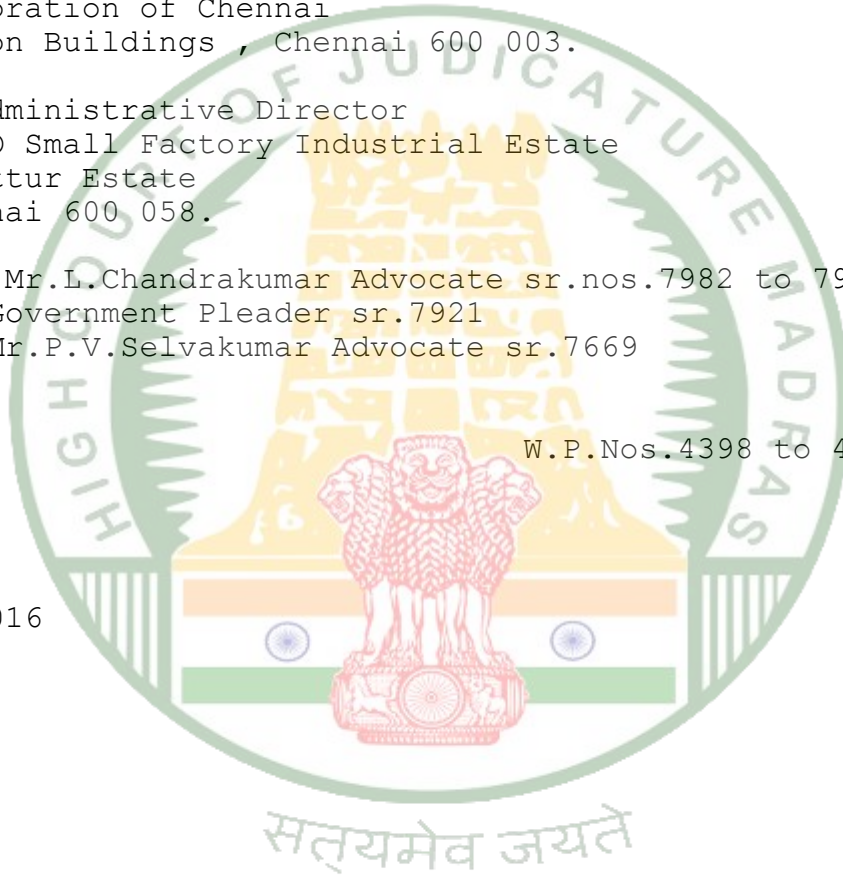
