Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus for a direction to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 05.02.2016 within stipulated period by the respondents and consequently direct the second respondent to allot the house to the petitioner at No.498, Ist Block, 3rd Floor, G.M.Pettai, Kasimedu, Chennai-13, under remuneration slum scheme, based on the petitioner's token No.127 issued by the second respondent herein.

ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus for a direction to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 05.02.2016 within stipulated period by the respondents and consequently direct the second respondent to allot the house to the petitioner at No.498, Ist Block, 3rd Floor, G.M.Pettai, Kasimedu, Chennai-13, under the remuneration slum scheme, based on the petitioner's token No.127 issued by the second respondent herein.

2. It is the case of the petitioner that her family members are residing under the hut for more than 20 years in Indira Nagar, Pallam, G.M.Pettai, Kasimedu, Chennai-13. On 04.12.2004, the entire hut was removed from the said area by the second

respondent, who issued token to the petitioner in No.127 in respect of the house allotted by the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board at G.M.Pettai, Kasimedu, Chennai-13. Even after a lapse of more than 11 years, there is no house allotment to the petitioner by the second respondent. The petitioner came to know that house No.498 is being kept as vacant in 1st Block, 3rd Floor, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board flats at G.M.Pettai, Kasimedu, Chennai-13. Hence, she gave a representation, dated 05.02.2016 to the respondents for allotment of the said vacant house under the slum remuneration scheme, based on the above said token number issued by the second respondent. Since the said representation is still pending, the petitioner has filed this Writ Petition for the above relief.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the respondents, who took notice for the respondents.

4. Considering the factual aspects of the matter, without going into the merits of the case, this Writ Petition is disposed of, with a direction to the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 05.02.2016 and after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and necessary parties, dispose of the said representation, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
